

3 PORT

2. Pull cables through panel opening. Terminate the 110Connect Modular Jacks according to Instruction Sheet 408–3278.

## NOTE

The faceplates accept the 110 jacks with the keystone size face. They will NOT accept the discrete (DEC†) version.




Figure 2

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

- 3. Align movable latch with "TOP" marking molded onto inside of faceplate. Insert terminated jack, at a slight angle, into back of faceplate until latches snap into place (see Figure 2).
- 4. Insert appropriate icon.
- 5. Install faceplate into modular furniture according to Instruction Sheet 408–3314.

NOTE

To remove a modular jack, insert a screwdriver tip over the movable latch and pry down slightly to release the latch. Pull jack out back of panel.

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction sheet provides assembly procedures for the faceplate kits listed in the chart in Figure 1.

## 2. DESCRIPTION

The FLEX-MODE faceplate kits include a faceplate, two spacer tubes, and one set of icons for identifying data or telephone receptacles.

## 3. INSTALLATION PROCEDURES

1. Remove panel knockouts from modular furniture.
