



Observe the following before installing and using this product:

- A readily accessible disconnect device shall be incorporated in the building installation wiring.
- Installation and servicing should be done only by qualified service personnel and should conform to all local codes.
- Use stainless steel hardware to fasten the unit to outdoor surfaces.
- Connect conduit hubs to the conduit before connecting them to the enclosure.
- Use only UL Listed conduit hubs rated 4X and UL Listed strain-relief bushings rated 4X.
- Protect against risk of unintentional operation or damage.

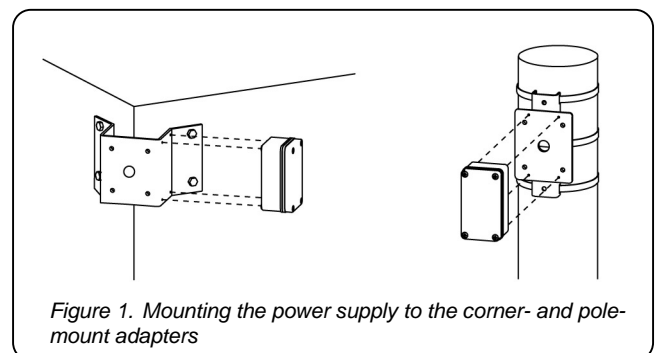
INSTALLING ON A FLAT VERTICAL SURFACE

- 1) Loosen the four cover screws and remove the cover with the screws attached.
- 2) Mark the location of the four mounting holes using the included mounting template.
- 3) Prepare the four mounting holes in accordance with the type of mounting surface (concrete, wood, etc.) and fasteners (not provided).
- 4) Secure the unit to the wall with the appropriate fasteners.

ATTACHING TO A CORNER- OR POLE-MOUNT ADAPTER

See Figure 1 and perform the following.

- 1) Loosen the four cover screws and remove the cover with the screws attached.
- 2) Secure the power supply to the adapter with the supplied fasteners.

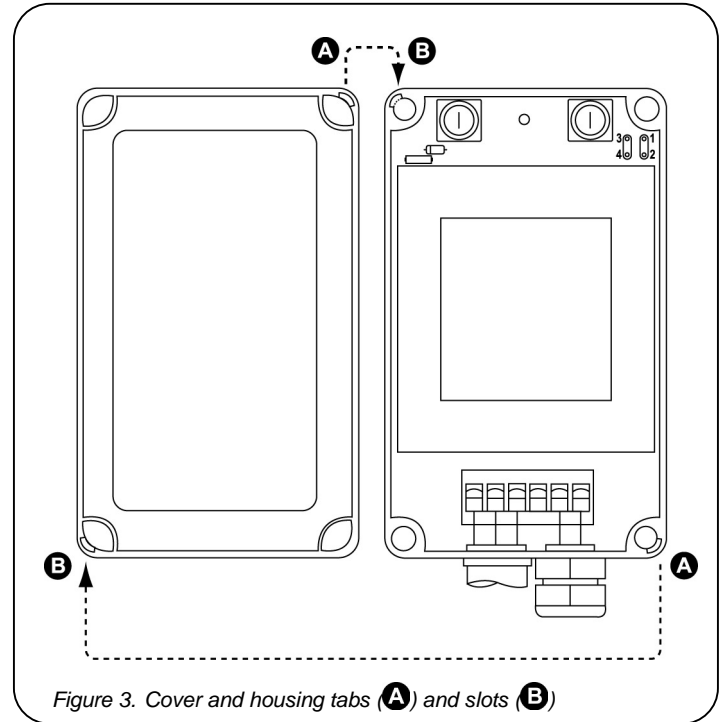
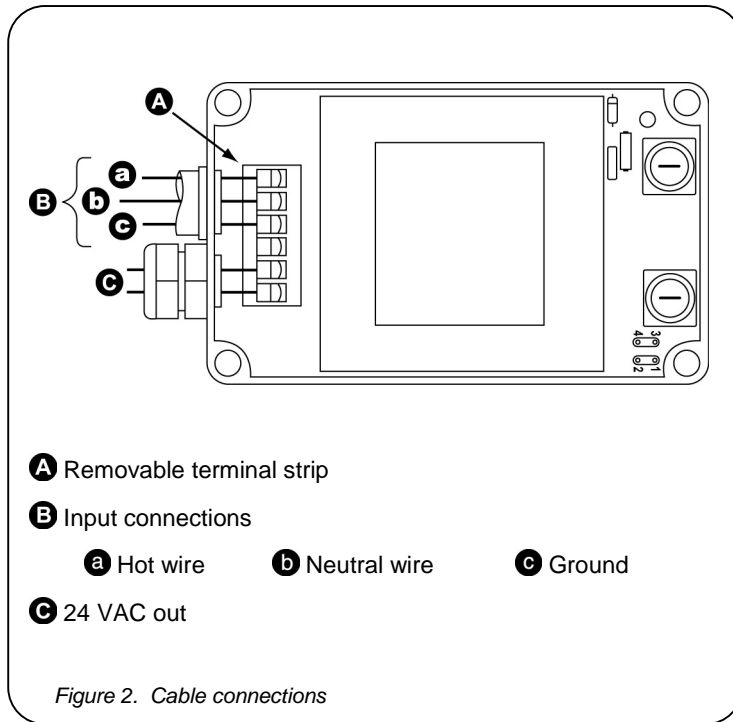

COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION

See Figure 2 and Figure 3 and perform the following.



- 1) Make cable connections to the removable terminal strip.



CAUTION:

When you replace the cover, properly align the keyed tabs and slots on the cover and housing to prevent the cover from leaking. See Figure 3.

- 2) Replace the cover by aligning the keyed tabs and slots.
- 3) Tighten the screws securely to ensure a watertight seal.
