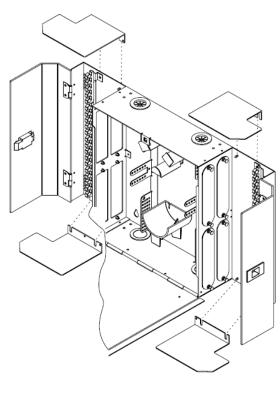

Installation

- **Step 1:** Loosen the 6-32 self-locking nut holding the top right strain-relief bracket using a 5/16-inch nut driver but do not remove.
- **Step 2:** Remove the vinyl cap from the pem stud.
- Step 3: Place dust cover with TWO holes over the top right jumper port (and/or the bottom left jumper port for WCH-12P). Ensure that dust cover is over the pem studs and between the jumper strainrelief bracket and the housing.
- **Step 4:** Place dust cover with ONE hole on the bottom right jumper port (and/or the top left jumper port for the WCH-12P).
- **Step 5:** Adjust the dust cover to fit flush with the housing and secure with a 6-32 self-locking nut. Retighten the previously loosened nut where applicable.
